PhD selections

- **Spring Call:** 1 March – 15 April

Interviews end of May, latest PhD start date January 1st of the following year

- **Autumn Call:** 1 September – 15 October

Interviews end of November, latest PhD start date June 1st of the following year

All group leaders of the doctoral school review the written applications in April and October

Only recruiting PIs conduct the interviews

“Prime your PhD” introductory course

Mandatory, 3 weeks full time:

- In January-February (for PhD students recruited in Spring Call)
- In June-July (for PhD students recruited in Autumn Call)

Monday seminar

Every Monday, 12:30 – 13:30

PhD students and Postdocs present (~ every 18 months)

Faculty provides feedback to the speakers after the seminar (13:30 – 14:00)
